Remember, even if you're not on a driving tour, you may attend the Hoxie Firehouse Fish Fry on Saturday and/or the Exhibitor Breakfast on Sunday.

3-Day Tour: "Through the Woods" - Thursday, September 21st through Saturday, September 23rd
NOTE: Please make 3-Day Tour hotel reservations at the Inn at Woodstock Hill asap – see hotel information below, on p. 2. We depart Olde Mistick Village parking lot (north side near I-95) at 1:00PM Thursday. Please eat lunch and fill-up beforehand. Our trip to the Inn at Woodstock Hill will make the usual stop at Clyde's Cider Mill and from there go over to Rhode Island, where you will see the Great Walls of RI. Dinner will be à la carte at the Inn. Confirm you will attend dinner at check-in. The Chef's Menu will include soup or salad, a choice of three entrees, a selection of desserts, and coffee/tea. The \$40/person (includes taxes and gratuity) and will be charged to your hotel bill.

On Friday, we leave after breakfast at about 8:30AM and go back to Rhode Island. This time you will have a rare privilege of visiting a classic car facility. Out of respect for the vehicle owners' privacy, we will not be able to take photographs.

Lunch will be at Blackie's Bulldog Tavern in Smithfield (pay there). From here we head to Ernie Ross's Farm.
